

ReStore Warehouse 7th Annual Recycled Art Show

The Re-Store Warehouse Annual Recycled Art Show, held at the Re-Store Warehouse 205 Forsythe St., has been part of the Fayetteville's Dogwood Festival for the past seven years. Local artists design artwork from recycled materials for the show. A panel of art enthusiasts will judge entries and award prizes.

Guidelines:

Complete and return the entry form with your artwork by April 17, 3PM. Include a complete description of artwork and quality photographs of up to three individual pieces.

Artist statements about the individual; pieces or the concept of recycled art may be included.

Entries of all types and sizes are accepted. Space is limited. Please contact the Re-Store Warehouse in advance if you require space for a large scale piece.

Submitted artwork will be considered "Recycled art" if it is entirely or primarily composed of material(s) that would have been disposed of via landfill or incinerator. With respect to the Re-Store's reuse mission, special appreciation is reserved for materials that are used or manipulated in their original form, without the extensive reprocessing (eg. Using raw aluminium because it contains a high percentage of beverage cans is desired less than using the original beverage cans.)

Artwork will not be for sale or sold during the show. Selected pieces must remain on display for the duration of the show. Artist cards or brochures may be on hand during the event. Post-event sales must be conducted by each artist individually.

All entries will be eligible for prizes according to entry categories. Artist may enter their work in more than one category. A special People's Choice Award will be given for the work that receives the most work.
